December Financial Update

Headsets for those with hearing aids was also discussed to assist hard of hearing parishioners to hear the service better. A motion was made by Jessica Summerfield to reimburse Chad for the camera of \$436.96 and to have up to \$2,000.00 available for Chad to make purchases for the new technology, Mary Brown 2nd; motion passed.

The cost of snowplowing both the front and back of the church parking lot, plus the driveway at the Parsonage is \$185.00 each time they come to plow. Nancy Beduhn asked if W/ELCA could help with the cost. Gloria Rolstad made a motion to give \$1,000.00 to the church for snowplowing, for the 2022-2023 winter season, Pat Rupp 2nd the motion. Motion passed. Will revisit the financial support for snowplowing in future years, if needed.

For Christmas 2022, a monetary gift was given by W/ELCA to the Pastor, Organist, Visual/Sound Technician, Secretary, and Custodian. W/ELCA will revisit this discussion at the September 2023 W/ELCA Quarterly meeting to determine if this will continue in future years.

W/ELCA Meeting January 14, 2023

The meeting was called to order by Co-President Joan Sorenson. Joan read the prayer and all those in attendance read the Purpose Statement.

The total made from the Deer Hunter Widower's Craft Sale was \$2,478.55, which included proceeds made from the 34 items at the Silent Auction. The Gift of Warm Clothing was given \$2,238.00 and the rest of the proceeds going to W/ELCA.

Jay's Carpet Cleaning service will be coming to clean the carpets at church and at the Parsonage during the week of January 22nd. Date to be determined.

The Community Thanksgiving Dinner was held inside the Fellowship Hall for the first time since Covid began. A total of 155 dinners were served with 104 dinners served in the Fellowship Hall and 51 dinners for take-out. This is the most ever served for the Thanksgiving Community meal.

The Apple River Conference Leadership Training scheduled for October 22nd was cancelled due to the lack of registrations to attend.

New Business: Chad Strege and Nancy Beduhn had talked about the need for better technology for the church. Chad presented various options for new equipment to replace or upgrade the current system in place at church. Chad had purchased a new camera for a cost of \$436.96 and said the cost of new speakers for the Fellowship Hall will cost about \$480.00 and a new microphone system will cost approximately \$900.00.
