We are off to a slow start for Lent because of the weather we are experiencing. We cancelled our Ash Wednesday service in favor of an "Ash Sunday" on February 26th. This leads us into the month of March, which is entirely in the season of Lent.

The word "Lent" is from an Anglo-Saxon word Lencten or Lenchthen which mean the lengthening of the days as Spring appears. As new life evidenced in leaves budding, and vegetation once again turning green, it points forward in time to the new life Jesus brings, beginning with his resurrection from the dead.

Lent begins forty-six days before Easter in spite of the fact that Lent is a season of forty days. This is because Sundays are not part of Lent. Sundays are considered "little Easters" in our Lenten journey. The start of Lent depends on when Easter occurs. In 325 a.d., the church decided Easter would fall on the first Sunday after the full moon which occurs on or after March 21.

Lent is a penitential period. Personally I like to think of it not so much giving up something, or worrying excessively about some sin we want to overcome (important as that may be). Rather I like to think of it as a coming to the end of ourselves, and letting Christ have control of our lives.

I wish you a blessed Lent. It is a time of fellowship as we partake of soup suppers, and gather around *The Holden Evening Prayer*. I am planning on presenting various ways of praying the Scriptures for our meditation on Wednesday evenings. Soup will be at 6:00 p.m. and the service will be at 7:00 p.m. I hope to see many of you during those services.
