Train children in the right way, and when old, they will not stray" (Proverbs 22:6).

"You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might. Keep these words that I am commanding you today in your heart. Teach them to your children and talk about them when you are at home, and when you are away, and winning you lie down, and when you rise ... " (Deteronomy 6:5-7).
