

#### **Property Report: Report given by Nancy**

- •Signed a contract for a 3rd company to try and make a claim on the roof damage with Church Mutual.
- Picked out vinyl plank flooring for the parsonage living room and hallway at Kemis flooring in Milltown.
- We had a successful day cleaning up the church: windows were washed inside. Bushes were trimmed and weeds were pulled all around the building and the playground. Power washing and washing the outside windows still need to be finished.
- It was noted that all the rock borders should be removed and weed barriers should be put down before the rocks go back.
- Sue Saarem continues to clean closets and organize our storage spaces.
- We now need to organize a day to clean-up the parsonage. The bushes need to be trimmed, weeds pulled, all cupboards and shelves wiped down.
- Deacon Jodi plans to move her things here in the week of November 5 and then move in officially in later November. Ben & Danielle Buck plan to go out to drive her moving van here. Nancy continues to work with her to make arrangements.
- We will also need to get together a group of people to move her things into the parsonage when the moving van arrives.
- We may be able to pay for the cost of her moving with the money we will save from salary savings for the month of November. (One estimate for just loading the truck was \$1,800 and the truck rental will be about \$1,000.)
