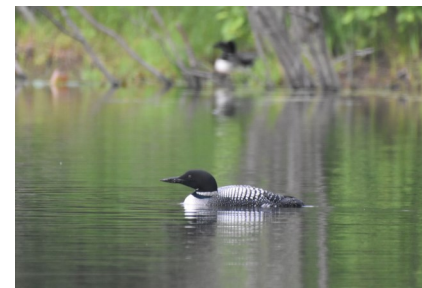

June 6, 2024 5:30 p.m.

Book Discussion: The Ruthless Elimination of Hurry by John Mark Comer, we plan to finish the book for the next meeting.

Called to order: Meeting was called to order by President Shahla Brown @ 5:46

Treasurer's Report: Laurene updated the council on financial aspects of the church.

Denise made a motion to accept the treasurer's report, Gloria seconded the motion, motion was voted on and passed.

Newsletter Article: July - Shahla

June Meeting Minutes: Nancy made a motion to accept minutes; Shahla seconded (electronically submitted on 6/17/24) Motion passed on 6/21/24.

Property Report:

Jon reported water problems again, at the parsonage. These issues were beyond his experience. Nancy began calling well plumbers. Most were unavailable, as it was Mother's Day weekend. Kirk Hischer's company agreed to come on Monday.

A replacement well pump was installed on Monday.

Jon has installed the new battery in the emergency light in the hallway,

He needs a big ladder to reach the two in the sanctuary and fellowship hall.

Nancy is still working on working with the insurance company to get the roof replacement from hail damage.

Other work that needs to be done on the church is: the bottom layer of siding needs to be renailed with the correct type of nails, we need to have bushes in the front of the church removed, plus have the rock layer around the church removed and cleaned out and have weed guard laid with the rock back over it. Nancy is planning on getting some estimates from a couple landscape companies on the landscape work that needs to be done. Track lighting in the sanctuary needs to be looked at and possibly replaced.

Randy made a motion for more discussion to be had on hiring a maintenance person full or part time to do upkeep on the church, Gloria seconded this motion. Motion was voted on and passed.

Deacon's Report: Deacon reported that her home visits, communion and weekly text studies continue. She is grateful to those who have taken time to drive her around to show her the area. She is excited about a small group Bible study that meets and is looking forward to the possibility of worshiping outside.

Old Business:

The LEAD Journey -- Nancy plans to reach out to the endowment committee to see about funding this project

Carpet fundraising - Denise give a brief update-we are currently at \$2300+ Council position --we are all praying on this

New Business:

June 30 - Picnic Potluck & Outdoor Worship - *Gloria will order buns from Wayne's*

Review designated funds - We are going to merge some so there aren't so many sitting in places that aren't being used at this time and they will be:

Youth and Children account merges the Sunday school balance, Educational Youth Speaker/Concert balance, Youth balance into one.

Property and maintenance will combine Men's group balance, AED and Community Meal Balance into one.

Music and Worship will combine Worship outreach balance, Sound and video balance and Sound system balance into one.

Randy made a motion to accept these new names and changes with a second from Gloria, motion was voted on and passed.

Review pianist stipend - Discussion on increasing Lisa's wage. Randy made a motion to increase Lisa's pay to \$100 and Gloria seconded the motion. Motion was voted on and passed to increase Lisa's pay to \$100 a week

Discussion purchasing a weed whip for the church-Randy made a motion to let Andy Brown purchase a weed whip for the church, Denise seconded the motion. Motion was voted on and passed.
