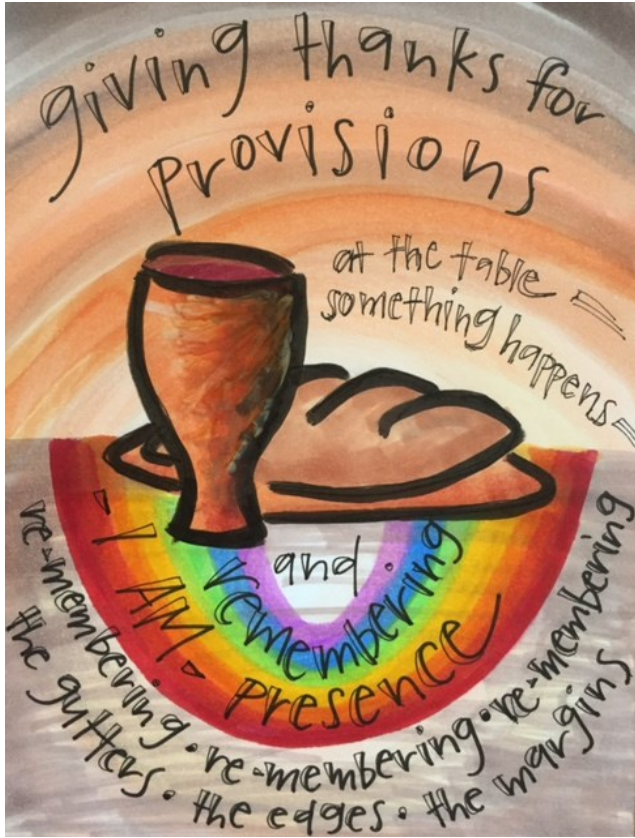

Bone Lake Lutheran Church Council Meeting October 9, 2024 5:00 p.m.

Present: Randy Kelly, Denise Nelson, Shahla Brown, Laurene Edge and Nancy Beduhn and Lil Wilson

Called to order: By president Shahla Brown at 5:02

High and Lo's were shared by all.

Approve Agenda: Randy made motion to accept the agenda and Nancy seconded the motion. Motion was passed to accept the agenda.

Treasurer's Report: Laurene-updated council on financial aspects of the church. Quarterly report still to come to congregation. Nancy made a motion to accept the treasurer's report and Lil seconded the motion. Motion was carried.

September Meeting Minutes: (Minutes electronically submitted on 9/17/24) Gloria made a motion to accept minutes; Randy seconded; Motion passed on 9/20/24.

Property Report: Jon Erickson installed 2 grab bars in the upstairs bath and shower of the parsonage.

Wayne and Jean Boatman and Nancy installed a new stair rail going down to the basement, and railings on both sides of the stairway up to the garage at the parsonage. Battery powered lights at both ends, of the stairs to the garage

Jean Boatman painted the downstairs bedroom and bathroom, and Nancy replaced the stained ceiling tiles at the parsonage.

The septic was backing up at the parsonage. Nancy called Olson Septic and they came out to do an emergency pump out, at the cost of \$200. Marion Olson checked with the county and there was no record of the tank ever being pumped.

Jake Jensen said he would try to match the carpet to what's in the hallway at the church. No date yet on when it will be installed.

Old Business: The LEAD Journey - Shahla reported that the process has been slow to get moving forward. The team has realized that it really needs 1-4 more people to make team effective and, so far, Karoline White has agreed to join the team.

Quarterly budget report - Laurene working on this.
