Approve Agenda: Randy made a motion to accept the agenda and Denise seconded the motion.

Treasurer's Report: Laurene gave an update on the March financials and the first quarter of the year. Randy made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Leora Seconded. Motion carried.

March Meeting Minutes: (Minutes electronically submitted on 3/16/25) Gloria made a motion to accept the minutes; Shahla seconded; Motion passed on 3/17/25

Property Report: Current items Randy is working on is:

1- finding the church a new insurance company. He is working with Jon Sorenson from Milltown, more to come on this.

2-Randy is meeting April 11th at 1pm with a group of men from the church to look at the septic at the parsonage and run the camera into the pipes to see what is going on with the drain field, more to come.

Deacon's Report: Thankful to all the wonderful speakers we have had this Lenten season and for the insights they shared. A huge thank you to Chad, Lisa and Shahla for sharing their talents during our Lenten midweek evening services and for all the wonderful soups and bread.

Other ministry sightings: Karoline and the LEAD team have completed a grant from the Synod Mission Endowment to help fund half of the 2025 LEAD expenses. The team is preparing to meet with small groups, prioritizing the survey questions that were distributed and completed. Listening to God, each other and our neighbors remains the focus.

When the power went out recently, I opened the church so people could charge devices and fill water jugs if needed. We posted this on our Facebook Page and Laureen sent out an email informing people the church was available if needed. When the power was restored, I locked up and went home. No one came to the church for water or to charge devices, perhaps this isn't a need in the community or perhaps people aren't used to having the church open for such an event? Not sure.

Chad and I streamed a Sunday service together when church was canceled.

- Savannah Schommer reported on the status of her revitalization project at the church - So far 3 rooms have been painted including the narthex & hallway, kitchen, and tent room. She has \$162 left in her budget but needs more for paint and supplies to finish painting. She also asked if we might cover the cost of replacing the 3 toilets in the bathrooms, installing LED bulbs, and other decor needs.
- Mary Brown made a motion to approve up to \$1,500 for the additional costs to the revitalization project; Pat Rupp seconded; Motion carried
 - Spring Fling/Bake Sale/Silent Auction Jessica reported that the spring fling, etc... will be held on May 3rd. Please start baking and cleaning closets. So far, we have 14 kids signed
 - up for camp. We are waiting on final responses from just a few more. Due to rising camp costs, WELCA will need to cover the deposits for the campers this year.

New Business:

- Saturday, April 12 the Apple River Spring conference will be held at Our Savior's Lutheran Church at 217 Deronda St in Amery. Let Joan know if you would like to attend. The cost is \$15.
- Judy Randall made a motion to increase the amount given to the church's general by \$1,000 per year beginning immediately; Savannah Schommer seconded; Motion carried
- Pat Rupp made a motion to give \$1,000 to the Unity Lions Club for their bed-build through Sleep in Heavenly Peace (SHiP); Mary Brown seconded; Motion carried. The bed-build will take place at the Polk County Fairgrounds on Saturday, April 19th.
